In the present writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed on 30.04.2014 (Annexure P6). Respondent was stated to be Anganwari Worker who was appointed on 2.4.1991. Her services were terminated on 12.09.2007. Labour Court passed award in favour of the respondent-workman to the extent of reinstatement with continuity of service along with 50% back wages. Undisputed facts are that there is violation of Section 25F in terminating services of the respondent-workman. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that there were allegations against respondent-workman

relating to embezzlement of government money. In the absence of holding of any inquiry merely on the allegations services of respondent-workman cannot be terminated. Therefore, petitioners have not made out case so as to interfere with the award passed by the Labour court dated 30.04.2014 (Annexure P6).

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
