By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the impugned order dated 12.10.2015 (Annexure P-6) vide which claim of the petitioner for stepping up of pay equal to his junior-Raj Mal-respondent No.5 has been wrongly and erroneously rejected and a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant notional/actual promotion and re-fix the pay of the petitioner equal to his junior-Raj Mal, SSA and others along with all other consequential and attended benefits along with payment of arrears of pay and pension along with an interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though legal notice dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-7) was duly served upon the respondents but till

date no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforementioned legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 01.09.2016 (Annexure P-7) and reconsider the same, that too, after hearing the petitioner and by passing a speaking order, in accordance with Services Rules and Instructions as well as notification issued from time to time, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by respondents, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
