This petition is filed by the petitioners for seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to consider their representation dated 19.1.2017 (Annexure P-12) for taking action against respondents No.6 & 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are only asking for registration of the FIR against respondents No.6 & 7 but from the reading of the petition, I could not find that the petitioners had ever invoked the provisions of Section 154 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 [for short 'the Cr.P.C'] for registration of the FIR before approaching this Court.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to make an application for registration of the FIR, at the first instance, to the SHO concerned.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
