In respect of their grievances, the petitioners are stated to have made a representation to respondent no. 3, a copy of which is shown to be Annexure P-5, which it is stated has not been decided so far.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Specifically a short date for deciding the representation is being given, as it is contended that the petitioners are being paid only Rs. 1000/- per month, which *prima facie* at least would seem to be even below the minimum wage for a workman, especially as the petitioners are said to be deputed for work at night.

The competent authority would also take into consideration the policy of the Government annexed as Annexure P-2 with this petition, while passing the speaking order.
