Ms. Rukhsaar Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

For the nature of order, I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statement is necessary to be filed on behalf of the respondents, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being finally disposed of.

The limited grievance of the petitioners is that although their application under Section 28A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, for re-determination of the compensation was accepted by the Land Acquisition Collector, Dholbaha Dam, Construction Circle, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.4) and they were awarded compensation in terms of the award rendered by the Reference Court, dated 01.08.2013 (Annexure P1), but they have still not been disbursed the compensation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Rajinder Kumar Rana, SDO, O/o Executive Engineer, Maile Construction Division, SCO-37/3, Sector 17E, Chandigarh, submits that the claim of the petitioners is being processed and the requisite amount in terms of the order dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P3) shall be disbursed to them within two months from today.

That being so, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of in the wake of the statement made by the learned State counsel.
