Petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court dated 17.04.2012 (Annexure P/11).

Petitioner is stated to have been appointed as an Operator in the Vijay Metal Works, Rewari. While working as such he was transferred to sister concern of the Vijay Metal Works, namely, Vipin Metal Works. Petitioner is stated to have been abandoned the service in the month of June, 2002. In this regard, respondent No.2-Vipin Metal Works issued number of letters and so also notice to the petitioner to report back to duty which is evident that petitioner has abandoned the service. Those communications, postal acknowledgments were exhibited before the Labour Court vide Exhibits MW1/B to G. The petitioner has not countered those documents stating that those letters/notices have not been received by him before the

Labour Court. Thus, it is evident that petitioner has abandoned the service in the month of June, 2002. Accordingly, no interference is called for insofar as Labour Court award dated 17.4.2012 (Annexure P/11) is concerned.

Petition stands dismissed.
