The challenge in the present writ petition is to the condition mentioned in the recruitment process for the post of Shift Attendant in the notice dated 30.04.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby twice the number of vacancies have been called for interview.

It is the case of the petitioners that as per news item published on 14.08.2017 (Annexure P-5), it has been provided that three times candidates will be called for interview, but the action of the respondent for calling twice the number of advertised posts is not justified and resultantly, seek quashing of the said notice.

The matter has already been considered by this Court in **CWP No.18878 of 2017 'Sukhbir Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others'** decided on 29.08.2017. The notification dated 11.08.2017 to the above fact whereby candidates equal to three times of number of vacancies was kept into consideration. Accordingly, it was held that the same was at a subsequent point of time and would not

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as such govern the earlier advertisements, specially wherein it had been earlier notified on 18.06.2015 that candidates were not to exceed twice the number of vacancies.

Resultantly, for the same reasons, the present writ petition also dismissed.
