The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to count the service rendered in the Government Aided School on Government Aided post for the purpose of qualifying service towards pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner does not have the documents with him to show that he had applied through proper channel. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now his restricted prayer is only for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioner within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of

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this order after considering the law point and the fact that whether the said benefit have already been granted to the similarly situated employees.
