The petitioner is the Gram Panchayat of village Gobindsar, Tehsil and District Pathankot. It alleges that an eviction order was passed against the private-respondent Nos.7 to 10 under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 against which the private-respondents have filed an appeal but no stay has been granted. It is further alleged that despite that eviction order, the private-respondents have raised construction on the site as may be seen from the photographs (P-8).

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner-Gram Panchayat, it appears that the appropriate recourse for the petitioner-Gram Panchayat would be to seek execution of the eviction order which is stated to be operative. The District Development and Panchayat Officer, Pathankot and the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Pathankot are directed to expedite execution of the eviction order in accordance with law and principles of natural justice. Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of filing the execution application.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
