Learned State counsel has produced the record of the last four candidates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the experience certificate has already been issued to the petitioner.

As per the record, the last candidate is having 74.33 marks and in case two more marks of experience are added in the marks of the petitioner, still he is much lower in the merit than the last candidate. Accordingly, nothing survives in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the experience certificate has been issued on wrong facts as he has been shown absent for 11 days, whereas the petitioner was not absent. He seeks liberty to avail the appropriate remedy in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the experience

certificate in any manner.

Dismissed with the said liberty.
