**JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)**

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the disability convenience allowance to the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a legal notice dated July 13, 2016 (Annexure P-6) was served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the legal notice (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated July 13, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and to take a conscious

decision in accordance with law as well as in the light of instruction dated June 07, 2011 issued by Government of Haryana, Department of Finance (Annexure P-1) and permanent disability certificate bearing No. Neuro/17/306 dated April 27, 2017, which subsequently conveyed to the Civil Surgeon, Sonapat vide letter No. PGIMS/MB/17/6999, dated May 04, 2017 (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, in case the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by competent authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
