By way of this writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order of his termination dated 15.6.2015 (Annexure P-6).

The contention raised in the present writ petition is that the services of the petitioner have been wrongly terminated on the ground that he passed Matriculation from the Board of Higher Secondary, Delhi.

Learned AAG Haryana has pointed out that in another case bearing CWP No.17499 of 2015, Rafik Mohd. Vs State of Haryana and others, the Union of India filed an affidavit bringing to the notice of the Court that the Board of Higher Secondary, Delhi was a bogus board.

In the circumstances, no fault can be found with the impugned order and consequently, this writ petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
