Petitioner has challenged the validity of order of transfer dated 27.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) and rejection of his representation dated 21.11.2015 (Annexure P-7).

Petitioner is in the cadre of Constable. One of his leg has been amputated. Therefore, he requested for retention at Sonapat. The same was not considered by the competent authority. Hence, the present petition. By virtue of interim order, petitioner is continuing at Sonapat even to this day.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that in view of the amputation of one leg of the petitioner, he would be given lighter duty as per the guidelines of the respondent-Department. If the petitioner is provided lighter duty, then there is no hurdle for him to go and work at the transferred place. The respondents are hereby directed to give effect to the

order of transfer dated 27.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) w.e.f. 1.11.2017.

With the above observations, petition stands disposed of.
