By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to forthwith release GPF/PF to petitioner as per rules and regulations, as till date her benefits have not been released till date.

Petitioner-Jaswinder Kaur, who is present in the Court has been identified by her counsel Mr. Vaibhav Narang, submitted that she has already been granted the benefit of GPF claimed through the instant petition and nothing survives more.
