The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus/certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents vide which the recovery is being effected from the petitioner in view of the assessment orders dated 28.03.2004 and 11.12.2007 (**Annexures P-4 & P-6**) respectively, passed by respondent No.2, whereas he has left the company after one year and therefore, he is not liable to pay any amount.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail any other alternative remedy as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
