Petitioner, who is working as Elementary School Head Master, challenges his transfer from Government High School, Tejpur (3852) Block Ateli, Mahendergarh to Government Middle School, Sulela (6069) Block, Ferozepur Jhirka, Mewat, on the ground that it is a different cadre and the said station was never opted by the petitioner.

It is the case of the petitioner that he had filled 72 options in different schools for his transfer and the list of opted schools is appended as Annexure P-2. A perusal of the said list would also go on to show that the petitioner had only opted for schools in Mahendergarh District and for no other district. It is his grouse, however, that as per the policy, while referring to Clause 10 that Mewat cadre is a separate cadre and therefore, until an option is given, the petitioner was not to be posted in Mewat district. It is his grouse that he has already represented on 04.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.1, but no action has been taken on the same.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Harish Rathee, Sr.DAG, Haryana accepts notice. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

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Keeping in view the above and the fact that a representation has already been moved (Annexure P-4), this Court is of the opinion that respondent No.1 shall take a decision on the same. It will be open to the petitioner to supplement the said representation within a period of one week, to give some other choice of District.

With the above-said directions, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
