In the instant petition, the petitioner has questioned the validity of the initiation of inquiry dated 04.12.2013 which is Annexure P-3. The charge sheet has been filed in the disciplinary proceedings. It is learnt that on the very same allegation, petitioner was subjected to criminal proceeding. This Court stayed the passing of final order in the disciplinary proceedings in view of the pendency of the criminal case.

During the pendency of this litigation, the petitioner is stated to have been acquitted in the criminal case. Consequently, in the disciplinary proceedings, final order is required to be passed. The concerned disciplinary authority to the petitioner is, hereby, directed to pass a final order and communicate the same to the petitioner.
