By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release of the annual increment of the petitioner for the services she has rendered for the period 01.01.2014 to 31.12.2014 and also direct that this annual increment may be included while determining the last pay drawn for the computation of retiral benefits of the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated November 17, 2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to the respondents but neither any reply has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.6 to decide the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated November 17, 2016(Annexure P-4) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulation and instructions issued from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
