Through, instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent to issue all the service benefits, promotions, retiral benefits and further the benefits issued by the government to employees of respondent-department from time to time.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though legal notice dated 17/21.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) was duly served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken by the respondents. He further contends that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.3-General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Jagraon Depot, Jagraon, Ludhiana to decide aforesaid legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3- General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Jagraon Depot, Jagraon, Ludhiana to consider the claim(s) of the petitioner unfolded in his legal notice dated 17/21.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) and to decide the same, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
