In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award of the Labour Court dated 06.05.2014 (Annexure P-1).

Respondent workman raised an industrial dispute. The Labour Court while deciding the Refefence No.175 of 2013 proceeded ex-parte for Management and ordered that respondent-workman is entitled to reinstatement in service with continuity of service and back wages to the extent of 40% w.e.f. 6.3.2013 onwards. The petitioner remained ex-parte before the Labour Court. Hence, award dated 06.05.2014 (Annexure P-1) is set aside and the matter is remanded to the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-I, Gurgaon. Parties are hereby directed to appear on 10.10.2017

before the Labour Court. Parties are requested to cooperate in deciding the reference before the Labour Court, so also the Labour Court is requested to decide the reference within a period of 4 months from the date of appearance of parties i.e. from 10.10.2017. The respondent-workman is entitled to cost of litigation expenses. The same shall be paid by the petitioner to the extent of ₹ 35,000/- within two months from today.

Petition stands disposed of.
