Petitioner has posed a challenge to the order dated 29.5.2017 passed by Deputy Commissioner, Ambala. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after death of his brother, he submitted an application for transfer of stamp vendor licence in his name. However, he was informed that his application had been consigned to record. His only grievance is that speaking order was not passed despite the fact that there is a provision in the rule for transfer of the licence.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of with a direction that Deputy Commissioner, Ambala may afford an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and take a decision on his application as deemed fit.
