The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is to order dated 18.11.2016 (**Annexure P-13**) whereby the petitioner-Firm was debarred from participating in future tendering process in Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh (in short, 'the Corporation') for a period of two years.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents-Corporation has produced a copy of the communication dated 10.03.2017 issued by the Chief Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh addressed to the petitioner wherein it has been stated that office order No.CE/MC/69 dated 28.02.2017 regarding debarring the petitioner-Firm from participating in future tendering process in the Corporation

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for a period of two years w.e.f. 18.11.2016 has already been withdrawn. It has been further stated that now the matter is listed for personal hearing of the petitioner before the appropriate authority on 06.04.2017 for further proceedings in accordance with law. The said communication is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. In view thereof, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the parties that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
