By virtue of the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.2 & 3 to disburse/release the ACP's, revised pensionary benefits, illegally and arbitrarily withheld since July 31, 2010 and interest thereupon @ 12% per annum from the date of actual retirement.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice was issued to the respondents on May 25, 2017 (Annexure P-3) but till date neither any reply to the said legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned authority.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his legal notice dated May 25, 2017 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, 30 Bays Building, Sector 17, Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated May 25, 2017 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order according to rules and instructions particularly in view of Notification dated March 04, 2014 (P-1) and another Notification dated August 25, 2014 (P-2) issued by Finance Department, Government of Haryana within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
