Pursuant to the order dated 02.12.2017 an affidavit of Sh.Vijay Singh Dahiya, Director General, Higher Education, Haryana, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, who submits that as a matter of fact a requisition has been sent by the Department to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, for issuing an advertisement seeking applications for appointment of 162 Laboratory Attendants, and further, as regards the posts of Peons, on which some of the petitioners are working on contractual basis, sanction for appointment of 24 Peons has also been sought from the Chief Secretary to the Government of Haryana (in the General Service-I Branch), vide a letter dated 18.11.2015.

That being so, these petitions are disposed of with a direction to the respondents that the posts in question as are held by the petitioners shall not be filled in during the interim by any other person other than the petitioners, except by way of regular recruitment, unless the conduct of any of the petitioners warrants removal, but by due procedure.

No other point has been raised.
