1. The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the direction issued by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI)/The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) dated 30.04.2008 (Annexure P-3) regarding the appointment of the Managing Directors/Chief Executive Officers in State Cooperative Bank/District Central Cooperative Banks-A follow up action on the recommendation of Vaidhanathan Committee's Report, 2006 and the Government of Haryana vide Memo No.1992-C-8-2009/21249 dated 16.12.2009 (Annexure P-6) has approved the policy for the appointment of Managing Directors/Chief Executive Officers by

adopting the Fit & Proper Criteria prescribed by the RBI. Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to comply with the Division Bench judgment of this Court passed in CWP No.4460 of 2016 (PIL), titled as '*Prem Raj Sharma vs. State of Haryana and others*' dated 19.07.2012 (Annexure P-9).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently certain essential facts could not be incorporated and relevant documents could not be appended along with the present writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action by incorporating all the necessary facts as well as by appending all the necessary documents.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
