1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to allocate the work of the "House Keeping Services" Tender 2016 (Annexure P-1) and execute the "Contract Agreement" with it being L-1. Further prayer has also been made to restrain respondent No.1 to offer the "Housekeeping Services" tender work to respondent No.2 (being L-2).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present

writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.1, at the first instance, by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation in respect of the claim made in this writ petition. However, it was prayed that a direction be issued to the said respondent to decide the said representation, in a time bound manner after affording an opportunity of hearing to it in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is observed that in case, a detailed and comprehensive representation is filed by the petitioner to substantiate its claim as made in the present writ petition, before respondent No.1 within ten days from today, the same shall be decided by the said respondent within next fifteen days by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to it in accordance with law.
