It is contended that the petitioners were promoted in April/May 2006 as Junior Engineers and their names were reflected in the seniority list at Sr. Nos.20, 21 and 22, however, a tentative seniority list was prepared, in which, persons juniors to the petitioners herein have been shown promoted to the post of Assistant Trust Engineer. Aggrieved against the tentative seniority list, the petitioners herein sent a legal notice (Annexure P-3) through their counsel, challenging the said promotions made. It is contended that despite the legal notice having been served upon the Department of Local Government, too date, no action has been taken thereon nor their legal notice has been decided. Counsel for the petitioners

contends that at the present moment, he limits his prayer that the legal notice be decided as early as possible.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Avinit Awasthi, AAG Punjab, who is present in the court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Let three copies of the paper book be served upon him during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondents to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
