The petitioner, who is serving as Assistant Excise & Taxation Commissioner under the Department of Excise & Taxation, State of Punjab, has filed the instant writ petition impugning a communication dated 24.5.2017 (Annexure P-12) and in terms of which respondent no.2 i.e. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Govt. of Punjab had directed the Internal Complaints Committee/respondent no.3 to adjourn sine die proceedings which were pending before the Committee in pursuance to a complaint having been preferred by one Sunita Jagpal, Excise & Taxation Officer/respondent no.4 and against the petitioner. As per counsel the Internal Complaints Committee has acted upon the impugned communication dated 24.5.2017 (Annexure P-12) and has adjourned the proceedings sine die on 24.5.2017 itself.

Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail of his alternate remedies in accordance with law as also under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
