Petitioners are candidates for recruitment to the post of Constable (G.D.). For the purpose of selection and appointment, respondents proceeded with medical and written examination. Pursuant to the medical examination all the 3 writ petitioners were permitted to participate in the written examination. When things stood thus, process of recruitment got delayed. Consequently, under the policy of the respondents in respect of selection and appointment of Constable (G.D.) medical certificate or examination would be in vogue for a period of 180 days. Since process of recruitment was not completed within 180 days, thus, respondents resorted to subjecting the candidates for medical examination for once again and it was held on 20.08.2015. Insofar as petitioners are concerned all the 3 petitioners were suffering from one or the other deficiency. Based on the 2nd medical examination, petitioners name have

not been considered for selection and appointment to the post of Constables (G.D.). Policy of the respondents for selection and appointment to the post of Constable (G.D.) in respect of medical examination is concerned if candidate is found to be medically unfit for the first time there is a provision for review/appeal medical. Such a procedure has not been adopted and insofar as petitioners are concerned pursuant to the fresh medical examination held on 20.08.2015 wherein they have been found medically unfit it is to be noted that initial medical examination held in February, 2015 all the petitioners were held to be medically fit. In view of these facts and circumstances, concerned respondent is hereby directed to subject these petitioners for review/appeal medical examination for the purpose of selection and appointment to the post of Constable (G.D.).

The above exercise shall be completed within a period of 2 months from today and the result of review of appeal medical be communicated to the petitioners at the earliest.

With the above observation, CWP stands disposed of.
