The petitioners have approached this Court challenging the acquisition of land, where notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short “1894 Act”) were issued on 11.04.2002 and 08.04.2003, respectively. Award was announced by the Land Acquisition Collector on 06.04.2005. The land pertains to the revenue estates of villages Garhi Bohar, Kheri Sadh and Pehrawar. It was acquired for development of residential and commercial Sector 27, Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the issues raised in the present writ petition have already been considered by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **Uddar Gagan Properties Limited Versus Sant Singh and others, (2016) 11 SCC 378**, wherein acquisition of the land vide

petition can be disposed of in terms of the aforesaid judgment. She further submitted that wherever compensation has not been paid, the amount be paid to the land-owners.

Learned counsel for the State does not dispute the aforesaid fact that the present petition can be disposed of in terms of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **Uddar Gagan Properties Limited's case (supra)**. He further submitted that the amount of compensation, wherever is payable to the petitioners-landowners, shall be paid without any delay.

In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **Uddar Gagan Properties Limited's case (supra)**.
