One Vikram Singh, resident of village Bhangera, Tehsil Chachroli, District Yamuna Nagar filed eviction petition under Section 7(2) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, as applicable to the State of Haryana, against the private-respondents, which was allowed by the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade-cum-District Development and Panchayat Officer, Yamuna Nagar vide order dated 29.03.2016. The aggrieved private-respondents preferred an appeal which was allowed in part and the matter has been remitted to the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Yamuna Nagar for afresh decision. The short grievance of the Gram Panchayat in the instant writ petition is that after remand, no decision is being taken by the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade-cum- District Development and Panchayat Officer, Yamuna Nagar.

In the light of the prayer made by the petitioner, we dispose of this writ petition without expressing any views on merits, with a direction to respondent No.4-District Development and Panchayat Officer, Yamuna Nagar to decide the pending eviction petition afresh and in accordance with

law, within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
