A prayer in the instant writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to fix a date to conduct Punjabi Language examination for the petitioner to enable him to fulfill the recruitment criteria for vacancies advertised by the Punjab Government for the post of Punjab Police Constable etc.

After filing of the instant writ petition, Director, Department of Language, has fixed 22nd January, 2017 as a date to conduct the Punjabi Language test and the candidates are to apply to appear in the said examination by 19th January, 2017. A photo copy of the order fixing the date of the test has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the relief sought for stands satisfied, no further orders are called for.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
