The petitioner questions the rejection of his nomination papers by virtue of this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

We are afraid, we cannot entertain this petition in view of the settled law as determined by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *N.P.Ponnuswami v. The Returning Officer, Namakhal Constituency, Namakkal, Salem Dist., and others*, **1952 AIR (SC) 64** observing that acceptance or rejection of nomination papers cannot be made subject-matter of a writ jurisdiction.
