1. In the instant writ petition, grievance of the petitioner is relating to non-grant of 2nd and 3rd ACP as and when it is due to the petitioner.

2. During pendency of this petition, competent authority has extended the benefit of 2nd and 3rd ACP vide orders dated 30.03.2017 and 24.04.2017. Said orders have been placed on record by the official respondents.

3. In view of above developments, present petition do not survive for consideration. If petitioner still aggrieved by the orders dated 30.03.2017 and 24.04.2017, she is at liberty to file an independent petition. The official respondents are hereby directed to calculate and disburse the arrears of pay on account of 2nd and 3rd ACP granted to the petitioner. The above exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from today.

4. With the above observations, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
