Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner stood retired from service on May 31, 2016 but till date entire retiral benefits have not been paid to him. Rather an amount of Rs.88,034/- (Rs.74,445/- on account of stolen batteries + Rs.11,279/- amount of lubricants issued to Tempo Trax + Rs.2,310/- amount of servicing of Tempo Trax) has been placed in the miscellaneous advance of the petitioner illegally. Petitioner has also approached the authorities concerned time and again but no substantive action has been taken.

Petitioner has also served a legal notice dated May 9, 2017 (Annexure P-6) to the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken thereon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice (Annexure P-6) and take a conscious decision thereon.

Without expressing anything on merits and various averments made in the legal notice, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in

legal notice (Annexure P-6) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law as well as service rules within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.
