This order of mine shall dispose of three writ petitions,
whereby the petitioners have approached this Court against the attempt of
the Municipal Committee for seeking possession during the pendency of the

appeal preferred against the eviction order of the Collector dated 30.05.2014.

Mr. Raj Kapoor Malik, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner(s) submits that appeal preferred is pending adjudication but owing to the compelling circumstances, instead of seeking injunction before the Commissioner which could have taken much time, petitioners had approached this Court and this Court while issuing notice of motion had granted status quo regarding the existing position.

Written statement on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 in CWP Nos.1284 and 21 of 2017 has been filed today in the Court. Same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The factum of the pendency of the appeal is not in dispute.

Resultantly, I dispose of the present writ petitions by directing the Commissioner to decide their appeal as expeditiously as possible within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. However, till then status quo granted by this Court shall be maintained.

Accordingly, all writ petitions stand disposed of.
