Reply-affidavit filed on behalf of respondent No.4 is taken on record.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is an aspirant for admission to Civil Engineering (4 years' Bachelor of Technology Academic Programmes), for which he appeared in Joint Entrance Test (JEE) Main, 2017 held on 03.04.2017.

The admitted facts are that the petitioner, as per his merit in JEE (Main) 2017, was allocated for admission to Dr.B.R.Ambedkar National Institute of Technology, Jalandhar but he did not report till the cut-off date which expired on 26.07.2017. It is averred that the petitioner was suffering from acute jaundice due to which he could not appear. It is not in dispute that last date for admissions, as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court order, was extended to 15.08.2017 but till then also the petitioner did not appear. He chose to approach this Court in the 2nd week of September, 2017

when the cut-off date had already expired.

In these circumstances, no effective relief can be granted to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
