Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to the respondent/authorities to grant to the petitioner benefit of regularization in service.

During the course of arguments, counsel concedes that services of the petitioner have since been terminated.

Neither is the order of termination placed on record nor is there challenge to the same.

Under such circumstances, the prayer made in the instant petition seeking regularization in service cannot sustain.

Petition is dismissed.
