Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-1), whereby she has been transferred from Government Middle School, Rattpur (3772), Pinjore, District Panchkula, where she was posted as Sanskrit (C&V) Teacher, to Government Senior Secondary School, Bhareli (3717) Block Barwala, District Panchkula.

It is her case that it is a non-preferred/non-opted place of posting and therefore, the transfer dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) is not justified and the same is liable to be quashed.

Counsel has referred to Annexure P-3, wherein the preferences have been given, as Government High School, Tagra Hakim Pur (3735), Government Middle School, Manakpur Thakurdass (3762) and Government High School, Poploha (3730) have been opted for, as per the transfer policy dated 05.06.2017, as amended on 01.06.2017 (Annexure P-2). It is her case that as per the gradation given, she was having the merit of 57.263 whereas the others, namely, Ram Dayal Sharma and Krishan Balabh, who have now been posted at the above-mentioned stations, had lower merit of 55.0822 and 53.4931, respectively, as per the chart prepared by the respondents themselves on 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-7 Colly.) and therefore, seeks consideration, accordingly.

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Notice of motion.

Ms.Shruti Jain Goyal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to her.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merit of the case and keeping in view the above and since the petitioner herself has already represented for the redressal of necessary grievances on 07.09.2017 itself (Annexure P-5) whereby the grading and the stations have been mentioned, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the same, within a period of 10 days from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case an adverse order is to be passed, same should contain reasons and be communicated to the petitioner.
