The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, quashing the order dated 19.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.5 and order dated 20.05.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed respondent No.2. Further writ of *mandamus* has been sought for directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to permit the petitioner to cut the trees in her land.

2. The writ petition is totally bereft of material particulars. Accordingly, a prayer was made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one by furnishing complete particulars.
