The petitioner has prayed for re-issuance of passport which was denied on the ground of pendency of criminal cases against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that two FIRs were registered against the petitioner. Insofar as FIR No.251 dated 30.6.2009 registered under Sections 420, 467, 471 and 120B of the IPC at PS Civil Line, Amritsar is concerned, the same has been investigated and tried in which the petitioner has been acquitted on 9.1.2014 but the second FIR No.46 dated 11.6.2011 registered under Sections 420, 419, 467, 468 and 120B Act at PS Fatehgarh Churian is still pending though it is alleged that the matter has been compromised between the complainant and the petitioner but the said FIR has not been cancelled so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner thus prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition in order to pursue his remedy before the passport authority.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
