By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant all retiral benefits to the petitioner for the service rendered from October 1977 to 30.04.2014 for the service rendered in respondent No.5 Society (Principal Society) with 12% interest for delayed payments till the actual date of payment as per Full Bench judgment of this Court in “R.S. Randhawa v. State of Punjab, 1997 (3), RSJ 318.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.3-Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Bathinda to decide the legal notice dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) in the light of instructions dated 14.07.1995 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated

period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Bathinda to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) in the light of instructions dated 14.07.1995 (Annexure P-6) and take a conscious decision, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. As far as grant of interest on delayed payment is concerned that may also be considered in view of the observations made by Full Bench judgment of this Court in case captioned as ***“R.S. Randhawa vs. State of Punjab, 1997 (3) RSJ 318.***

4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
