Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the order transferring the petitioner from the Ambala depot to the Faridabad depot is not available with him, factually he was transferred to the Faridabad depot from Ambala depot in December 2015 but before he could even join at the Faridabad depot, he was transferred to Rohtak, the relieving order being Annexure P-1, dated 06.01.2016. Thereafter, within 1½ years, he was again transferred from Rohtak to Gurugram vide the impugned order dated 23.06.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Obviously, as per the aforesaid contention, the petitioner was 6 months short of the minimum period to be completed at one place as per the transfer policy Annexure P-3.

Since a large number of similar matters, challenging the transfers of Conductors and Drivers of the respondent-Haryana Roadways, have already been disposed of by this Court vide its order dated 01.09.2017 (the lead case being CWP no.17899 of 2017), this petition is also disposed

of in the same terms, with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider the case of the petitioner in terms of the directions issued in the aforesaid judgment and to issue posting orders to him within 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. After the petitioner joins at Rohtak, it shall be ensured that he is not relieved from there, except in terms of the policy Annexure P-3, complying with the aforesaid order of this Court and thereafter to ensure that he shall only be transferred out if there is any other person with longer stay than him at Rohtak, unless such person or the petitioner himself is covered by any of the exceptions carved out in the transfer policy.
