Petitioner, who was serving as E.T.T Teacher under the Punjab State Education Department, filed the instant writ petition seeking the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent authorities to promote her to the post of Punjabi Mistress w.e.f. the date her alleged junior had been so promoted.

Learned State counsel would submit that in the interregnum the promotion order of respondent no.4 Vanita Dhir has since been withdrawn. The withdrawal order stands appended as Annexure R-1 along with the written statement filed on behalf of the State.
