DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been transferred on four occasions since 31.5.2016 at the instance of respondent No.2 just to harass the petitioner. She was even allowed to join her duties after the intervention of Additional Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur. The petitioner has been threatened by respondent No.2 that she can be transferred at any time. It is also the contention of learned counsel that the petitioner has also made representation to respondent No.1 on 10.7.2017 (Annexure P-4) but no action has been taken thereupon. The petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to respondent No.1 to consider her representation dated 10.7.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without

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commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 10.7.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

Disposed of accordingly.
