By this petition the petitioner has challenged the order by which arbitral proceedings were terminated. It may be mentioned that arbitral proceedings were terminated under Section 38 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 because the petitioner had expressed its inability to pay the settled fees. Yesterday the matter had been adjourned.

Today learned counsel has stated that the petitioner has now made arrangements to pay the fees and will move an application for revival of the proceedings.

In the circumstances, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
