The petitioner seeks a direction that he may be allowed to contest the election of Municipal Council from Ward No.21, Gurugram scheduled to be held on 24.09.2017. The petitioner has not been permitted to file the nomination papers for which he claims to have approached the Authority on 13.09.2017.

In our considered view, the relief sought in this writ petition is wholly misconceived as no direction can be issued for acceptance of nomination papers or to allow the petitioner to contest the election. In the event the petitioner being deprived of contesting the election or casting his vote in an illegal manner, the remedy lies somewhere else.

With liberty to avail such remedy, the writ petition is disposed of.
