Petitioner, who is working as Multi-purpose Health Supervisor (Male), challenges the transfer order from PHC Murthal, CHC Juan, Sonapat to Civil Surgeon, Faridabad.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has been posted at Sonapat since 06.11.2013. However, it is his grouse that his family is settled at Sonapat and his wife is also in service at Sonapat. A representation dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) has been filed to respondent No.2 against the said transfer order.

It is settled principle that this Court will not interfere in transfer orders until they are found *mala fide* and arbitrary.

Faced with this situation, counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if respondent No.2 takes a decision on the said representation dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-3), within a time-bound frame, as Faridabad is at a distance of more than 100 kms. from Sonapat and therefore, his case needs to be considered sympathetically.

Accordingly, no further orders are called for and the present writ petition is disposed of. It is expected that the said respondent shall take into consideration the said representation and decide the same expeditiously.
