The dispute raised by the petitioner, who is a retired Associate Professor of respondent No. 3-College, is that he is entitled to payment on account of extra periods of teaching taken by him beyond the limit prescribed by the University Grants Commission.

It comes out that an Educational Tribunal has been constituted under the Punjab Affiliated Colleges (Security of Service of Employees) Act, 1974 and the Punjab Privately Managed Recognized Schools Employees (Security of Service) Act, 1979. The said dispute between the management and the employee is falling within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Educational Tribunal, Punjab. Therefore, the present writ petition is ordered to be transferred to the said Educational Tribunal, Punjab, having

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its office at Forest Complex, Sector-68, Mohali. Both the parties are directed to put in appearance before the aforesaid Educational Tribunal on 18.4.2017 at 10:30 AM.

In view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of.
