Since the impugned order expressly records that the Gram Panchayat gave its consent and had no objection if the passage was given to respondent No.3 who was the applicant before the Authority, we are of the considered view that the appropriate recourse for the petitioner-Gram Panchayat would be to approach the same Authority for recalling of the said order, if it has been passed on the basis of erroneous consent of the Gram Panchayat which was actually not given.

With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition is disposed of.
